





There are two big barriers to students using SEPTA: cost and familiarity. A monthly pass can be expensive on a student's limited budget, especially for students who ride transit for leisure. Further, the current fare structure and payment methodologies are among the most confusing aspects of riding for those arriving in Philadelphia for the first time. There's a solution to this problem:

The SEPTA Student Fare Discount Initiative!

Under such a program, educational institutions in the Philadelphia area could partner with SEPTA t unleash access to their entire student population for extraordinary discounts. Students 9 unlimited rides, schools can rely on SEPTA curricular engagement, and SEPTA receives predictable funding stream from new riders.
